Below are a few ideas -- things we need to discuss or make happen. These statements are only TENTATIVE. Nothing is for sure at this point. Everything needs to be discussed.

- Do we want to operate a special event station?

- Can we secure permission from Xerox to use the Xerox name on the air, in magazine articles (QST & CQ), and on certificates? (We have tentative permission at this point)
