

KARZ's Korner

Those of you that now me know that I'm somewhat enthusiastic about morse code (maybe "rabid" is a better word). In the fall, though, I become positively ecstatic. That's because I get to teach it to a whole new crop of perspective amateurs. There's lots to like about CW. Its perhaps the only universal language. On a mid winter night you can tune down to the lower end of 20 and hear two Soviet stations conversing in CW. They're not speaking russian. They're not exactly speaking english either, yet you can understand every word. That's recause the abreviations that have crept into CW over the years are universal. The Q signals

international. So are WX (weather), ES (and), TT (that), GG (going), 73, 88, DSW (Dasvedanya or goodby), and many others.

You can work CW without fancy equipment. The CW sub bands are the one remaining place where you occasionally find homebrew gear. You can get through on CW when you just can't make it on fone. That's why you can work ever rare DX on CW without a linear. Its only been in the last few years that digital modes have even come close to CW in its ability to geat through, and unlike those "other modes", CW has "personality". Even with electronic keyers, your "fist" is your signature. To beginners, copying CW can seem a chore, but with practice you become able to "copy in your head", and you only jot down notes - QTH, name, report - just like you would for a fone QSO. CW is engrossing and relaxing. When you're in the midst of a CW rag chew, its difficult to think about anything else. When I've had a particularly difficult day, I find a long chat on CW particularly relaxing.

The CW sub bands are definitely less crowded that the fone sub bands, so there's less hastle. Even when there is

hastle, CW ops seem to be more polite than their bothers up the band (although these days, there is rudeness everywhere - hi hi). Finally, there's the satisfaction of having a skill not everyone has. Its like knowing a foreign language.

Given all these advantages, Its sad to admit that CW is slowly dying. During last weekend's CW Sweepstakes contest. part of the exchange was the year in which the operator was first licensed. I worked 15 stations in the contest just for fun, and the average was 1968. That's 23 years ago! The most recent was 1985, and the next after that was 1978. Where were all those people licensed in '87, '88, '89, and '90? Heck, it doesn't take that long to get your code speed up. On the other hand, only one person was licensed before me ('58) and then, I got beaten by only one year. I observed more evidence of the decline of CW this afternoon when I operated for a few hours. The phone bands on 10, 15, and 20 were wall to wall stations while narry a signal could be heard on the CW portions.

I guess what I like about teaching the code is that its my chance to further a glorious amateur tradition in a mode that's challenging and fun, but if I am not advancing the venerable art of CW, at least I'm helping to slow its decline.
